Resolution 22-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE CENTER'S STATE ARPA GRANT PROGRAMS FOR SUBAWARD OF FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO THE STATE OF MISSOURI BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY ("TREASURY") PURSUANT TO SECTION 602(B) OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, AS ADDED BY SECTION 9901 OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT, (PUB. L. NO. 117-2 (MARCH 11, 2021)), 135 STAT. 4, 223-26, FOR STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS IN THE O'FALLON HILLS SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, under the terms of section 602(c) of the Act and Treasury's regulations, the State of Missouri has authorized the making of grants to authorized applicants to aid in the completion of specific public projects; and

WHEREAS, the State of Missouri has set aside \$150 million for stormwater infrastructure grants; and

WHEREAS, O'Fallon Hills Subdivision was constructed in the 1960's with open drainage including roadside ditches and driveway culverts; and

WHEREAS, the County accepted the improvements of O'Fallon Hills Subdivision prior to full development of the lots within the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the open drainage as it currently exists appears to be inadequate for the development that has occurred within the subdivision resulting in erosion and flooding; and

WHEREAS, residents have requested drainage improvements, including construction of new storm sewers; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Department intends to apply for \$5 million in grant funding to design stormwater improvements for the O'Fallon Hills Subdivision consisting of open drainage, curb and gutter, storm sewers, and water quality features at outfalls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ST. CHARLES COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the County Executive, Steve Ehlmann, be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application(s) on behalf of the St. Charles County with the State of Missouri for grant funding to aid in the completion of: a lead service line inventory, or a drinking water, wastewater, and/or a stormwater project to design and construct drainage and stormwater runoff water quality improvements including new storm sewers, curb and gutter, open ditches, drainage swales, and outfall treatments within the O'Fallon Hills neighborhood, an older lower income area which currently does not have adequate drainage infrastructure.

Section 2. That Steve Ehlmann, County Executive, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Missouri Department of Natural Resources may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized, to sign all necessary documents on behalf of the applicant, to furnish such

assurances to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources as may be required by law or regulation, and to receive payment on behalf of the applicant.
