RE: Bill for Introduction-Projected Tax Rates

Political subdivisions are required by Senate Bill 711 to furnish projected tax rates to the Registrar by April 8 so Projected Tax Liability Notices can be prepared by the Collector of Revenue. These notices are sent along with the Assessor's real property assessment notices to County residents to show property owners what their projected real estate tax bills will look like in 2023. The 2023 projected tax rates in this bill are based on the same tax rates levied on the 2022 real estate and personal property tax bills. The Road and Bridge tax is projected to be 17.39 cents and Dispatch & Alarm's rate is projected to be 3.34 cents. The General Fund tax rate remains at zero cents.
