Dear County Executive and Council Members:

The attached agreement is for the approval of the City of Wentzville's Road Board application for design and right-of- acquisition funding for David Hoekel Parkway from West Meyer Road to North Point Prairie Road as well as the transfer of fund from County Highway to the City of Wentzville for the design and right-of-way (ROW) acquisition funding for David Hoekel Parkway from North Point Prairie Road to Peine Road at US 61.

The completion of the David Hoekell Parkway corridor is a high priority for the County, as well as the City of Wentzville. Due to work loads and extensive coordination needed, it was determined that efficiencies would be realized if the two phases are combined and completed by one engineering design team. The County Highway Department's – David Hoekel Parkway Phase 5 – Road Board Application requesting \$1,550,000 was approved through last year's TIP. Work has not yet started, and the City of Wentzville has agreed to complete design and right-of-way for this phase, as well as the portion for which they applied for in the new cycle of Road Board applications requesting \$1,280,000 in County funds.

Transferring County Highway funds and approving the new application ahead of the normal TIP cycle will allow the City to start the work this year which is desired in order to expedite the project to construction in 2025.

These applications and allocation of funds have been approved by the Road Board.
