Before you is an ordinance authorizing the execution of an intergovernmental agreement to allow other police agencies to use the St. Charles County Police Department's Substance Tobacco Alcohol Resistance Training (S.T.A.R.T) curriculum. The success of this program has been recognized by agencies within the St. Louis and St. Charles region. As a result, multiple police agencies have requested authorization to adopt and use the curriculum when educating students about the dangers of substance abuse.

As part of the agreement, agencies agree to adopt the curriculum and make no modifications without authorization from St. Charles County. Additionally, each officer teaching the program will be trained by St. Charles County Police personnel to ensure the curriculum is taught properly.
