Youth Activity Park Open till Midnight for Late Skate Sessions

St. Charles County, Missouri – The popular Youth Activity Park (YAP), located at 7801 Highway N in Dardenne Prairie, will stay open late on June 16, July 21, Aug. 18 and Sept. 15. The 33,000-square foot outdoor skate park is the largest in the Midwest. The park offers numerous outdoor and indoor activities including two 30-foot sculpted rock climbing walls, a sand volleyball court, half-court basketball and a video game lounge.
