## Kick it up a Notch at St. Charles County Park's Camp Kickflip

*St. Charles County, Missouri* – Learn over-the-top moves at Camp Kickflip, the popular skateboarding program being held at the Youth Activity Park (YAP), 7801 Highway N in Dardenne Prairie. Spring week-long sessions are available from March 25 – April 5, and summer week-long sessions are from June 3 – Aug. 9. Learn the latest jumps, stunts and moves at this ultimate skate camp.

“The children who attend this action-packed camp get personalized instruction through team building games and activities,” said St. Charles County Parks Director Bettie Yahn-Kramer.

The 2013 sessions begin at 8 a.m. and end at noon daily. There is a fee of \$80 per session to attend the camp. Camp Kickflip attendees are in a supervised skating environment and will receive a camp T-shirt, water bottle, pizza party and free admission to the park.

The 25-acre Youth Activity Park is taking "extreme" sports to the next level with its 33,000-square foot skate course. Designed to provide a safe place for area youth to enjoy an assortment of alternative recreational opportunities, it's the largest outdoor skate park in the state of Missouri. Crafted of concrete, the facility offers challenges for every skill level with bowls, ramps, trick rails, and more! It also features two rock climbing walls, a sand volleyball court, half-court basketball, an open play area, table tennis, foosball table, and large video gaming area equipped with two flat screen televisions. Reserve an area of the indoor complex for the next birthday party, company picnic, or family function.
