Enjoy The Sounds Of The Season At St. Charles County Heritage Museum

St. Charles County, Missouri – The community is invited to enjoy the annual *Sounds of the Season at St. Charles County Heritage Museum*, 1630 Heritage Landing near St. Charles, from 1:30 – 4:30 p.m., on Sunday, Dec. 15. Presented by the St. Charles County Parks and Recreation Department, this popular musical program invites you to come in out of the cold, sip a cup of hot apple cider, and enjoy a variety of inspiring music while touring the innovative transportation exhibit at the museum. The first 50 guests will receive a complimentary 2013 commemorative ornament to remember the special occasion. This year’s musical performances include the Greenleaf Singers at 1:30 p.m., the St. Charles Community Singers at 2:15 p.m., and St. Elizabeth/St. Robert Regional School Choir at 2:45 p.m.

“This is the third year the St. Charles County Parks Department has hosted this free musical program at our historical museum and we encourage families to come out and enjoy the festivities,” said Parks Director Bettie Yahn-Kramer.

The interactive transportation exhibit, *On The Move...A History of Transportation in St. Charles County*, showcases rivers, rails and roadways in St. Charles County. Guests are encouraged to watch the musical performances in the museum meeting room and then explore the new exhibit. The exhibit features several interactive components, including touchscreen maps, a model bridge building area that is especially fun for children, and a steamboat pilot house computerized game that simulates the experience of navigating a vessel up the Missouri River. Other areas of the museum feature displays about the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroads and the bridges of past and present in St. Charles County.
