COUNTY COUNCIL TO HOLD APRIL 14 MEETING AT COTTLEVILLE CITY HALL

Executive Office Building expected to reopen to the public in mid-April after water damage repairs are complete

ST. CHARLES COUNTY, MO – In honor of the 175th anniversary of Cottleville's plat approval, the St. Charles County Council will hold its next regular meeting on Monday, April 14, at Cottleville City Hall, located at 5490 Fifth Street. The meeting will be held at 7 p.m. in the Board Chambers.

The St. Charles County Executive Office Building, located at 100 N. Third Street, St. Charles, is expected to reopen to the public by mid-April when water damage repairs from a pipe burst that occurred on Jan. 8 are complete. County Council meetings are expected to move back to the Council Chambers in the Executive Office Building as of the April 28 meeting.
