

Riverside Drive To Close For Three Weeks For Road Work

St. Charles County - A portion of Riverside Drive will be closed on Monday, March 5, beginning at 7:30 a.m., to allow for construction of a new storm sewer system. The road will remain closed for approximately three weeks. The construction area is located between McClay Road and Bridgehampton Drive just south of Bridgehampton.

Riverside Drive will remain open on either side of the closure area, but no through traffic will be allowed through the area of the storm sewer construction. Motorists may take Bridgehampton Drive to Watkins Glen to McClay Road to by-pass the closure. Signs notifying motorists of the closure and detour route will be posted.

This road project is part of a continuing effort by St. Charles County Government to improve the county's road system for the safety of the traveling public.
