## **COVID-19 Case Report**

The Department of Public Health reports the following:

<b>COVID-19 deaths</b>	60
<b>Persons being quarantined</b>	414
<b>Persons released from quarantine</b>	2,053
<b>Number of tests pending at the Missouri State Laboratory*</b>	0

*\*Tests are being performed at both the Missouri State Laboratory and through private testing laboratories. The number of pending tests is reported to the Department of Public Health by the Missouri State Laboratory only; private labs do not report pending tests to the health department.*

## **Today's News:**

- Today, Recycle Works Central, Recycle Works West and the Division of Humane Services' Pet Adoption Center joined other St. Charles County Government buildings in reopening to the public. Building restrictions are in place at County facilities, and appointments are required for visiting the Pet Adoption Center. View the [County's recent press release for information](#).
- The Department of Public Health has been notified of five additional COVID-19 deaths involving St. Charles County residents — increasing the total number of COVID-19 deaths in the county to 60:
  - #56 - A male in his 80s, reported on May 29.
  - #57 - A male in his 90s, reported on May 30.
  - #58 - A male in his 70s, reported on May 30.
  - #59 - A female in her 80s, reported on May 31.
  - #60 - A male in his 60s, reported this afternoon.

### ***Health Department Office, Recycle Works, Pet Adoption Center and Other County Buildings Reopen to Public***

The Department of Public Health office reopened to the public on Friday for printed copies of Missouri birth/death certificates, assistance with completion of U.S. Passport applications (by appointment) and STD testing (by appointment). Today, Recycle Works Central and Recycle Works West opened to full collection services during normal business hours, and the Pet Adoption Center reopened on an appointment-only basis, with limited animal interaction. In addition, the County Administration Building, the County Police Department and other County facilities are open. Residents may continue to receive assistance with all department programs [online](#) or by phone at 636-949-7400.

Please be aware that building restrictions are in place for all County facilities.
