## **COVID-19 Case Report**

The Department of Public Health reports the following:

<b>Number of tests pending at the Missouri State Laboratory*</b>	0

*\*Tests performed at both the Missouri State Laboratory and through private testing laboratories. The number of pending tests reported to the Department of Public Health is from the Missouri State Laboratory only; private labs do not report pending tests to the local health departments.*

### ***St. Charles County Parks Department Opens Off-Leash Facilities, Physical Distancing Recommended***

Today, the St. Charles County Department of Parks and Recreation reopened off-leash dog areas at [three county parks](#). The Department of Humane Services and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention note that while the risk of animals spreading COVID-19 to people is low, animals can spread other diseases to humans. Pet owners and caregivers are advised to wash hands after handling animals and their supplies or waste; keep pets current on recommended vaccinations; and avoid gathering in groups. Individuals concerned that they or their pets are exposed to COVID-19 should stay home and contact their medical provider or veterinarian for guidance.

### ***County Buildings Reopen; Online and Phone Services Continue***

As of Monday, June 1, most St. Charles County Government buildings have reopened to the public. Please be aware that building restrictions are in place, and appointments may be required for some services. Prior to entering a County facility, individuals will undergo a health screening, and those displaying a fever or other COVID-19 symptoms are not permitted to enter the building.
