Department of Public Health Recommends Residents Continue Precautionary Actions to Prevent COVID-19

The St. Charles County Department of Public Health recommends that residents [continue efforts](#) to keep themselves safe and protect others against COVID-19. Wearing a mask in public settings, practicing social distancing by keeping at least a 6-foot distance from others and regularly washing hands and commonly touched surfaces will help to reduce the spread of illness. Staff reminds individuals to wear masks properly, ensuring that it covers both the nose and mouth. Residents enjoying outdoor activities are also reminded to apply sunscreen and insect repellent to reduce harm.
