St. Charles County to Follow Missouri's Show Me Strong Recovery Plan

On June 15, St. Charles County Executive Steve Ehlmann announced that the county would follow Phase 2 of [Missouri's Show Me Strong Recovery plan](#), outlined by Governor Mike Parson. Phase 2 lifts previously issued restrictions. To prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Department of Public Health encourages individuals to continue precautionary actions, including:

- Social distancing.
- Avoiding large crowds.
- Wearing face coverings in public settings.
- Washing hands and surfaces.
- Staying home when sick or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.
