Addendum #3 is being issued in response to additional proposal inquiries received on July 9, 2013.

1. 6.1 question 11 Does your software interfere with the operation of standard Microsoft applications (Word, Excel, and Outlook), Internet Explorer, Windows Operating Systems and or Windows Server Operating Systems? Should the RFP say “Does the software interface.....”?
 - a. No, SCC DOC is asking if the application will cause issues (interfere) with the operation of standard Microsoft applications etc...
2. 6.1 question 75 If a visitor has an existing want does the system alert the user? Should the RFP say “warrant”?
 - a. Yes, “want” has the same definition as a “warrant”.
3. 6.9 question 1 Does your software integrate with Radiology? Who is the current Radiology provider? What is the current process for receiving information from Radiology?
 - a. Mobilex USA. Currently SCCDOC receive results via fax.
4. 6.10 question 3 Does your software automatically send medication orders or prescriptions to pharmacies? Do the providers currently have an electronic order entry process for medications? Does it include the back up pharmacy? When are backup pharmacy services required?
 - a. No, currently everything is paper form.
5. 6.10 question 5 If your software includes inventory routines, can you automatically adjust inventory levels as medications are received from the pharmacy? Will Diamond's inventory tracking processes be utilized?
 - a. SCC DOC currently does not have this capability.
6. 6.10 question 6 If the pharmacy offers an electronic MAR, can your software integrate with their MAR in real time? Does the county use the eMAR process provided by Diamond?
 - a. No
7. 6.11 Who is the Lab provider for the county?
 - a. Quest Diagnostics
8. 6.15 question 7 Is the software compatible with a Pharmacy service software package? Does the county use a pharmacy software in addition to the service provided by Diamond? If so, what is the software?
 - a. No

9. 6.19 question 1 Does your software include a Medication Administration Record (eMAR) component? Does the County utilize Diamond's eMAR?
 - a. No
10. 6.21 question 18 Does the system automatically display any active warrants for a name record? Should the RFP read" ...active warrants..."?
 - a. Yes, "want" has the same definition as a "warrant".
11. 6.22 question 16 Can encounter documentation be entered using voice dictation software? What is the current voice technology used by the County? Does the medical staff utilize the same voice technology?
 - a. SCC DOC currently does not use voice technology
12. 6.22 question 26 Can encounter documentation templates be exported from one correctional facility database to another correctional facility database? Please provide an example.
 - a. SCC DOC currently does not have this capability and is unable to provide an example.
13. 6.25 question 3 Can inventory items be directly tied to medication orders / prescriptions such that the creation and/or dispensing of a medication automatically reduces the inventory level for that item? What inventory management tools provided by Diamond does the County utilize or intend to utilize?
 - a. SCC DOC currently does not have this capability
14. 7.1 question 9 Prior to the implementation phase, will the vendor customize the database to accommodate the dictation/documentation needs of healthcare provider's and their staff? Please list current voice, document, and other health technologies utilized.
 - a. SCC DOC currently does not have this capability
15. 8 Cost Estimates - The Terms and Conditions state on page 3, " The contract shall be effective for the approximate twelve (12) month period from the date of the notice of award". Please clarify the intended length of the contract.
