Values: Participants were asked to discuss the following questions and write one value per post-it to be presented back to the entire group.

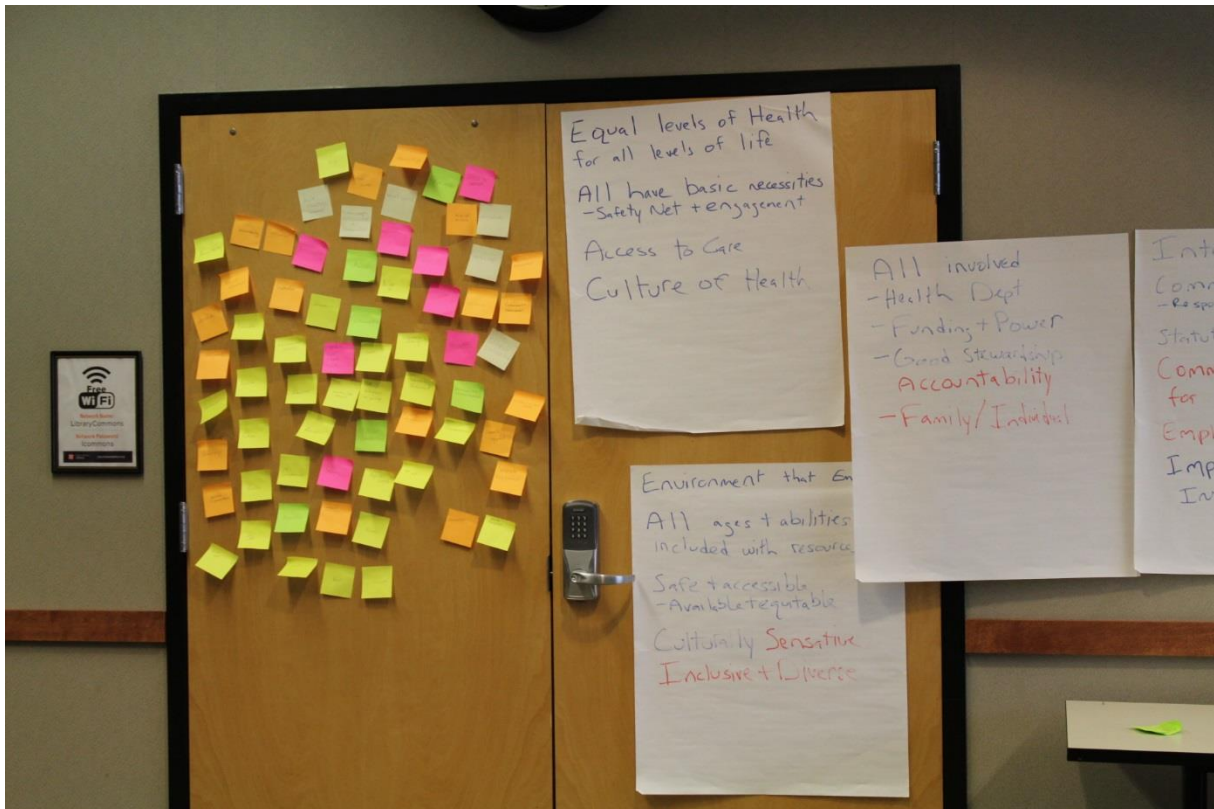
- **What are the key behaviors that will be required of the local public health system partners, the community, and others in the next 5-10 years to achieve the vision?**
