Special Use Addendum

Effective May 4th St. Charles County is following the state's Phase I plan for recovery from COVID-19 outlined in Missouri Governor Mike Parson's "Show Me Strong Recovery" plan. This plan allows residents to return to economic and social activities as long as they adhere to social distancing guidelines. There are currently no limitations on social gatherings as long as necessary precautions are taken and six feet of distance can be maintained between individuals and/or families.

Considering this planned resumption of activities, the St. Charles County Parks and Recreation Department will not be requiring cancelations of existing reservations for shelters and facility rentals. The Department's reservation policy is in effect which outlines terms for canceling or moving reservations.

We are now taking new reservations, conducting programs, and allowing special events to occur. In the interests of public health, however, we are asking everyone to think about your event and provide a plan for how the event will follow social distancing guidelines. This information will be reviewed and compared to the guidelines expected to be in effect at the time of the event. Failure to submit proper information requested by this addendum may result in revocation or denial of your Special Use Application.
