



Klondike Park

Camping Rules

- Camping is allowed in designated areas only. Sites marked reserved are occupied.
- Guests must be 18 years of age to reserve a campsite and be present during their stay.
- Tent sites accommodate up to two tents or five guests per location and feature a picnic table and fire ring. Tent camping sites are \$10 per night. Cabins must be reserved in advance, accommodate eight guests each and are \$65 per night. Linens not included.
- Check-in is at 3 p.m. and check-out at noon.
- All vehicles, including trailers are restricted to designated roads and parking lots.
- All pets must be kept on a leash and are not allowed inside cabins.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Music permitted but may not exceed 75 decibels per County Ordinance.
- No refunds for reservations under \$20, or less than 30 days prior to original reservation date.
- No glass containers allowed in any St. Charles County Park per County Ordinance.
- Hunting, discharging of firearms, and other weapons or fireworks is prohibited.
- Fishing allowed, but guests must comply with state laws, posted regulations and license requirements as established by the Missouri Department of Conservation.
- Swimming is not allowed in the park. Collection of firewood in the park is prohibited.
- All non-camping guests must leave the park when it closes one half hour after sunset.
- St. Charles County Parks is not responsible for personal property left unattended.
- Campfires are the responsibility of campers and are restricted to fire rings only.
- No RV or camping trailers allowed in the park.
- Any change to a reservation, including canceling or rescheduling, can only be arranged by the person whose name is on the reservation permit. To do so, that person must confirm the changes with park administrative staff prior to their stay by calling the office at **636-949-7535** during business hours.
- Shower house is closed and water is turned off from Nov. 1 through March 31. Non-flushable composting restrooms are available for use year-round.
- Guests may “walk-in” and reserve any available campsite by filling out reservation envelope and paying with cash.
- Campsites do not have electrical outlets.
- Camping is limited to 14 consecutive days within a 30-day period per County Ordinance.
- Campsite must be free of debris and trash before departing.
