PITMAN HILL ROAD MULTI-USE TRAIL

Project Location:

Pitman Hill Road from Chadwick Lane south to the Veterans Tribute Park entrance south of Sammelman Road

Project Description:

This project consisted of extending the existing multi-use path to the new Veterans Tribute Park. At the northern end of the project limits, the existing multi-use path ended just north of Chadwick Lane. South of Chadwick Lane, an existing creek crossing required the installation of a 10-foot-wide prefabricated bridge. Further south, another portion of the multi-use path was elevated in order to span a creek that had moved against Pitman Hill Road. In addition to this new stretch of multi-use path, the remaining existing sidewalk to the new park was replaced with wider path. Completion of this path allows access to the new park and the Katy Trail to the south. To provide access for bicyclists, ramps were installed at the intersection of Sammelman Road with Pitman Hill Road and Sammelman Road was re-striped to allow for two travel lanes and a curb protected directional bike lane along the north side of the road.

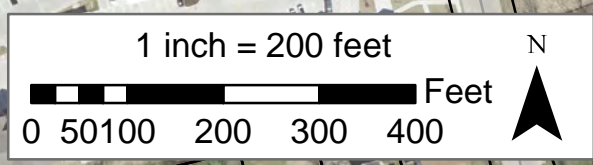
