ORF ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Project Location:

Orf Road from Highway N to Hawk Ridge Trail

Project Description:

This project reconstructed Orf Road from Highway N to Hawk Ridge Trail, an old County road that was annexed into the City of Lake St. Louis. The existing road was in poor condition and the existing horizontal alignment provided poor access to Hawk Ridge Trail. The owner of the adjacent land approached the City with plans to develop this property which had high commercial potential. Therefore, the City worked with the Developer to obtain funding to improve this roadway connection. The project reconstructed the road to a 3-lane section with two 12-foot lanes and a center 12-foot turn lane. The project also improved the horizontal alignment approaching Hawk Ridge Trail, added enclosed drainage and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk along the south side of the road. The funding listed below as “Other” was provided for by the Developer.

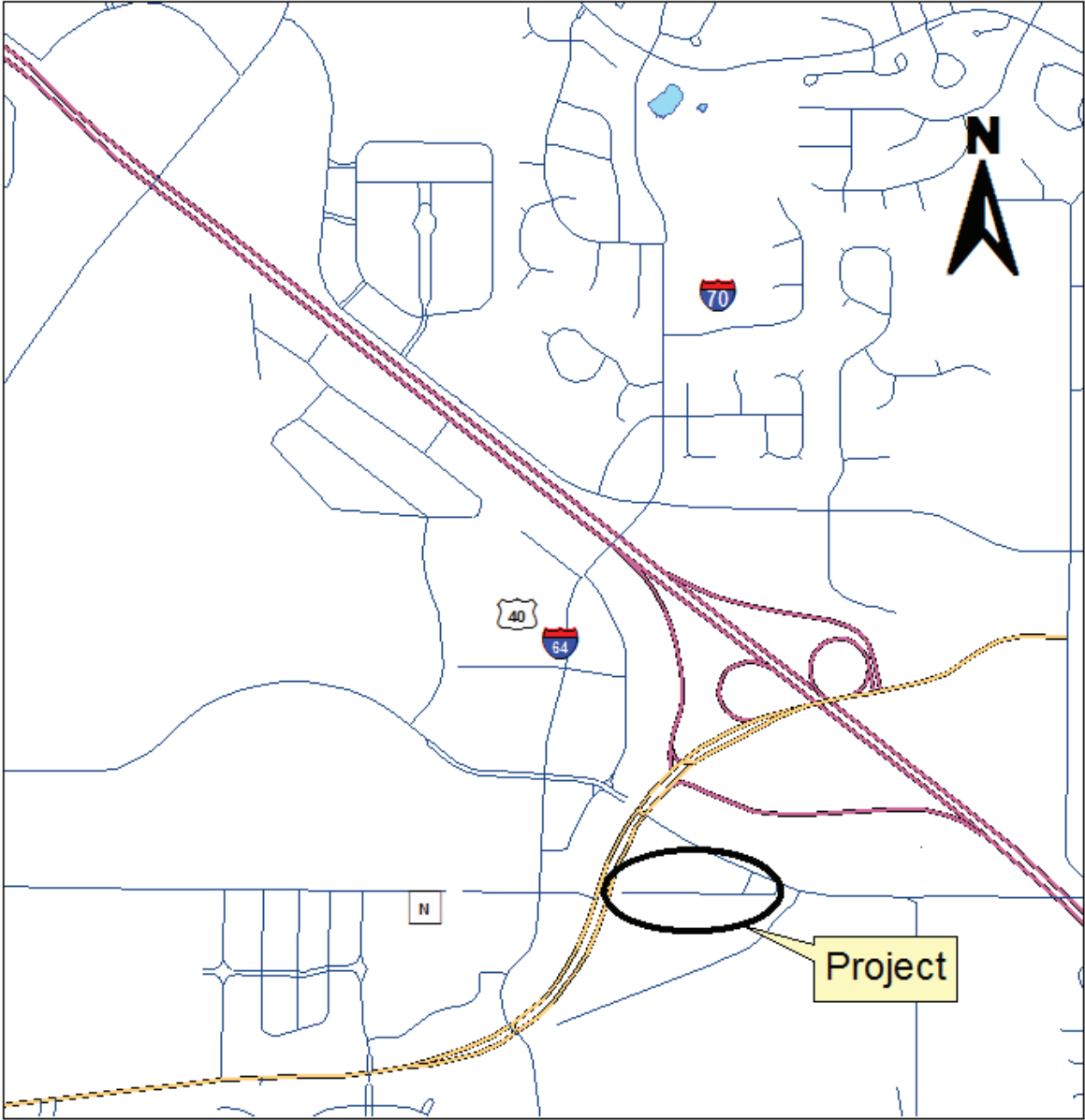

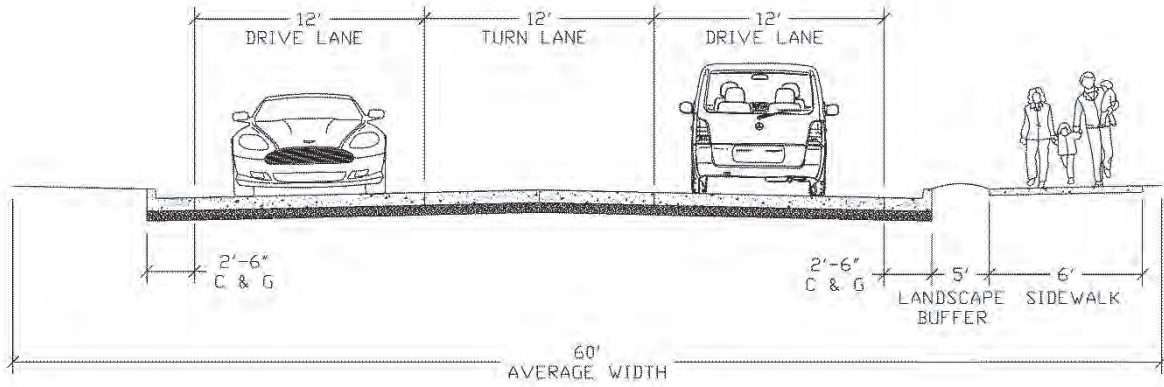
