FLASHING YELLOW ARROW - PHASE 2

Project Location:

Various locations within the City Limits of St. Charles

Project Description:

This project provided for the installation of new signal hardware, wiring, and signage to fully implement Flashing Yellow Left-Turn Arrow indications on all applicable approaches to various intersections within the city limits. The Flashing Yellow Arrow indication represents the same allowed traffic movement as a solid green indication, in that vehicles are permitted to make a yielding left turn. To provide for the best reduction in delay for the traveling public, the City decided to provide for a city-wide implementation of Flashing Yellow Arrows which included ten (10) city-maintained intersections and five (5) MoDOT maintained intersections. The attached map provides the location of the improvements. Federal funding was provided through the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program.

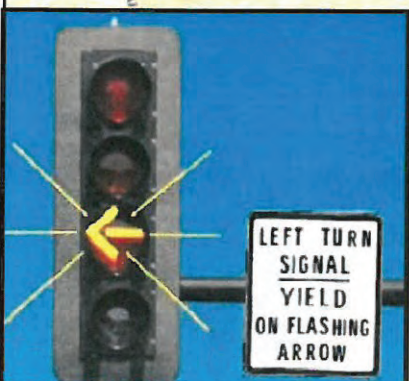
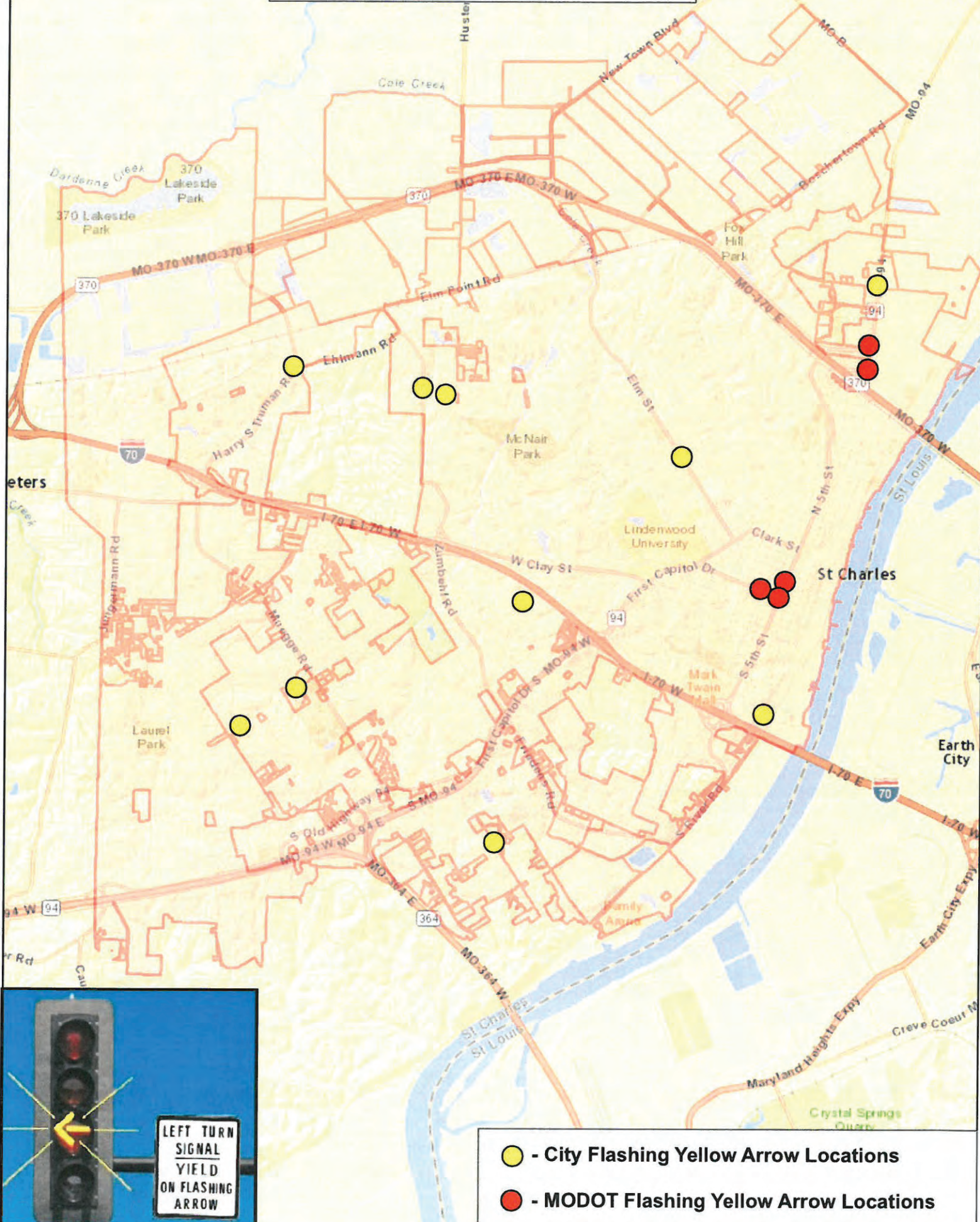
