## **NORTH POINT PRAIRIE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT**

### **Project Location:**

North Point Prairie Road over a tributary of McCoy Creek approximately 300-feet south of Scotti Road

### **Project Description:**

This project replaced a structurally deficient bridge structure on North Point Prairie Road. The County was notified by MoDOT that the structure's sufficiency rating had dropped dramatically and therefore required replacement. The project replaced the existing structure with a new wider and more hydraulically efficient structure. The existing bridge was replaced with a double 10-foot by 7-foot reinforced concrete box culvert. The new structure provides for a widened roadway section with two 12-foot lanes and 8-foot shoulders.
