NORTH DUCHESNE DRIVE EXTENSION

Project Location:

North Duchesne Drive from Mel Wetter Parkway to Randolph Street

Project Description:

This project constructed a new extension of North Duchesne Drive. The new 39-foot-wide roadway was constructed with concrete pavement and curb and gutter. A center median was provided for access management and pedestrian crossing safety. Openings were provided in the median only where turning movements were necessary and at all new mid-block crossings which provided pedestrian refuge. A new signal was installed at the new intersection with Mel Wetter Parkway which included widening along Mel Wetter Parkway for turn lanes additions. Roadway lighting was also provided along with a 5-foot sidewalk along the west side and a 10-foot multi-use path along the east side of the road. The funding listed as “Other” was provided by the Developer which included the cost of the design, right-of-way, and utility relocations needed to construct this new roadway extension. Funding provided by the County was for construction only.
