## MEXICO ROAD AND JUNGERMANN ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

### Project Location:

Intersection of Mexico Road and Jungermann Road

### Project Description:

To improve intersection safety and reduce congestion, this project provided for improvements at the intersection of Mexico Road and Jungermann Road. Both of these existing roadways are 5-lane arterials, with center turn lanes, curb and gutter, storm sewers, and sidewalks. They both carry a similar amount of heavy traffic, between 21,000 to 29,000 vehicles per day. Therefore the project improvements included lane additions, intersection geometric improvements, and ADA improvements. A lane was added in each direction along Mexico Road, allowing for two separate left-turn lanes westbound and a dedicated right-turn lane eastbound. The geometric improvements included larger radii for turning movements at the intersection. The ADA improvements included upgrades to the signalized pedestrian crossings and included new curb ramps at the intersection.
