MID RIVERS MALL DRIVE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS

Project Location:

Mid Rivers Mall Drive from Cottleville Parkway to Dye Club Road

Project Description:

This project provided for improves to Mid Rivers Mall Drive. This existing segment of Mid Rivers Mall Drive was the only remaining 4-lane section of road with an existing 8-foot-wide multi-use path along the west shoulder. Therefore to improve corridor safety, and reduce congestion and travel delay, the project provided for the addition of a continuous two-way left-turn lane. The turn lane was constructed from Cottleville Parkway to approximately 550-feet north of Dye Club Road. Additionally, the project provided for dual left-turn lanes from northbound Mid Rivers Mall Drive to westbound Cottleville Parkway. The existing Dardenne Creek Bridge was widened 12-feet to allow for the addition of the turn lane. To better accommodate both pedestrians and bicyclists, the project included a separated 8-foot-wide multi-use path along the west side of the road which connects to existing Great Rivers Greenway multi-use trails.
