Intersection of Central School Road and Highfield Drive

Project Description:

The existing intersection of Central School Road and Highfield Drive was an all-way stop controlled intersection. This intersection experienced severe congestion during peak hours due to several nearby schools. To help alleviate these congestion issues, this project removed this stop control and replaced it with a new traffic signal. The new traffic signal also included three new signalized pedestrian crosswalks and intersection lighting.
