## **INTERSTATE DRIVE PHASE 4**

### **Project Location:**

Interstate Drive from Hepperman Road to east of South Point Prairie Road (Journey Elementary School)

### **Project Description:**

This project provided for a new roadway connection between Hepperman Road and an existing portion of Interstate Drive to the west that previously dead-ended at Journey Elementary School. The road was constructed with concrete pavement and provides for two 12-foot lanes with 6-foot shoulders. The shoulder was constructed of full-depth pavement to allow for future widening and expansion of Interstate Drive. The road was widened at Hepperman Road to provide for a separate left-turn lane. To accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians, a 10-foot-wide multi-use path was constructed on the south side of the road. The new path connects to the existing path along Interstate Drive to the east which connects to Quail Ridge Park. The project was constructed with an open drainage system but has been designed to be converted to a curb and gutter, closed drainage system, when the road is expanded to a 4-lane section in the future.
