HIGHWAY N - PHASE 3

Project Location:

Highway N from Weiss Road to Eagle Hill Lane

Project Description:

This existing portion of Highway N was a deteriorated 2-lane section without shoulders, and prone to flooding. Therefore this project provided for the full reconstruction of Highway N. To improve safety and traffic flow, the roadway was widened to a 3-lane section to provide for the addition of a center two-way left-turn lane and new 4-footwide shoulders. The project provided for modifications to the horizontal and vertical alignment of the roadway to address some sub-standard curves and sight distance issues. Additionally, the flooding issue was addressed by raising the road elevation above the 100-year floodplain. To accommodate pedestrians and bicyclists, an 8-foot multi-use path was constructed along the north side of the road. The funding listed below as "Other" was provided by MoDOT's Cost-Share program.
