HAWK RIDGE TRAIL AND ROUTE N INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

Project Location:

Intersection of Hawk Ridge Trail and Route N

Project Description:

This project provided for improvements to the existing signalized intersection of Hawk Ridge Trail and Route N to increase capacity. These improvements included pavement widening on Route N for the addition of a second southbound left-turn lane to eastbound Hawk Ridge Trail. To accommodate this new turn, Hawk Ridge Trail was widened to provide for an additional eastbound lane which turns into a right-turn only lane at the new intersection with Orf Road. With two eastbound lanes, Hawk Ridge Trail, west of Route N, was also widened to allow for a second eastbound lane through this intersection. Additionally, a second westbound left-turn lane to southbound Route N was added. A new segment of sidewalk was added along Hawk Ridge Trail to connect sidewalk at the intersection with the residential subdivision located at Spring Borough Drive. The funding listed below as "Other" was provided by MoDOT's Cost-Share and St. Louis District funds.
