I-70 AND FIFTH STREET INTERCHANGE

Project Location:

Interstate 70 between Fifth Street and Route 94

Project Description:

This project was a partnership between the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), St. Charles County, and the City of St. Charles. The project consisted of several improvements at three interchanges along I-70 which included Fifth Street, Convention Center Boulevard (Fairgrounds Road), and Route 94/First Capitol Drive. These improvements included the reconfiguration of the Fifth Street interchange to a new Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) and the reconstruction of the overpass at the Convention Center Boulevard interchange along with the addition of on/off ramps. A new collector/distributor north outer road was also constructed between the interchanges of Fifth Street and Convention Center Boulevard. At the Route 94/First Capitol Drive interchange, the project included adding additional capacity on I-70 in both the eastbound and westbound directions. The funding listed below as "Other" was provided by MoDOT Cost-Share program.

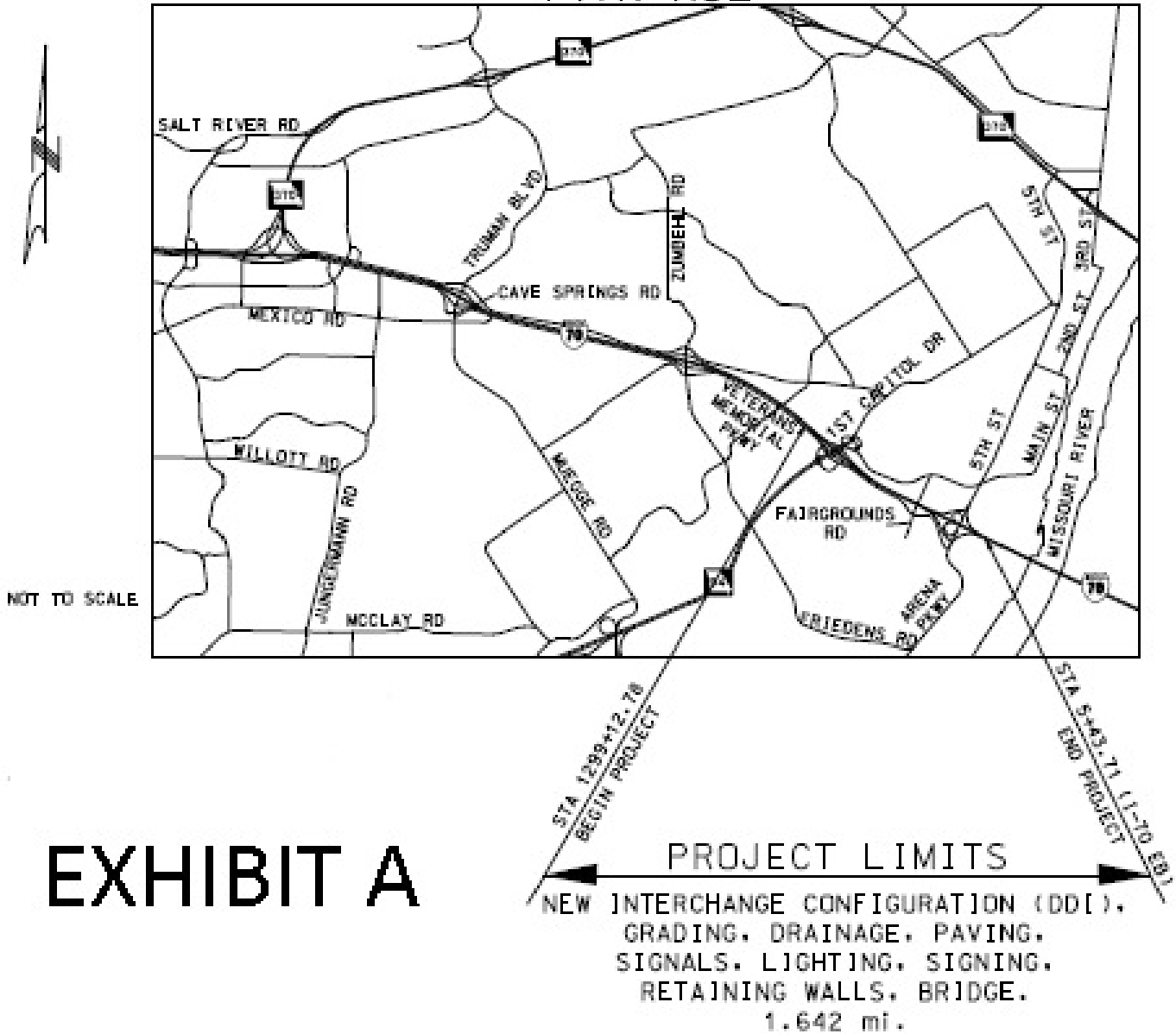
