KINGSHIGHWAY TRAFFIC FLOW IMPROVEMENTS

Project Location:

Kingshighway from Monroe Street to Jefferson Street

Project Description:

This project provided for traffic flow improvements along Kingshighway which included converting the existing 4-lane road to a 3-lane road with one lane in each direction and a center turn lane. The project also provided for the rehabilitation of the existing asphalt pavement with a 2-inch mill and overlay along with the removal and replacement of non-ADA compliant sidewalks, curb ramps, and crosswalks. To provide for better access management, a few entrances widths were reduced. Signal equipment was also upgraded to allow for interconnection between existing signals.
