WEST PEARCE BOULEVARD AND MEYER ROAD TRAFFIC SIGNAL

Project Location:

West Pearce Boulevard from Meyer Road to Cheryl Ann Drive

Project Description:

The two intersections of West Pearce Boulevard with Meyer Road and Cheryl Ann Drive were originally configured as all-way stop controlled intersections. This resulted in long queues and delays for the corridor during peak hours. Therefore, this project converted the intersection of West Pearce Boulevard and Cheryl Ann Drive to a 2-way stop controlled intersection. The intersection of West Pearce Boulevard and Meyer Road was widened to convert to a signalized intersection. This intersection was also upgraded for improved pedestrian connectivity with new curb ramps, signalized pedestrian crosswalks, and ADA compliant push buttons.

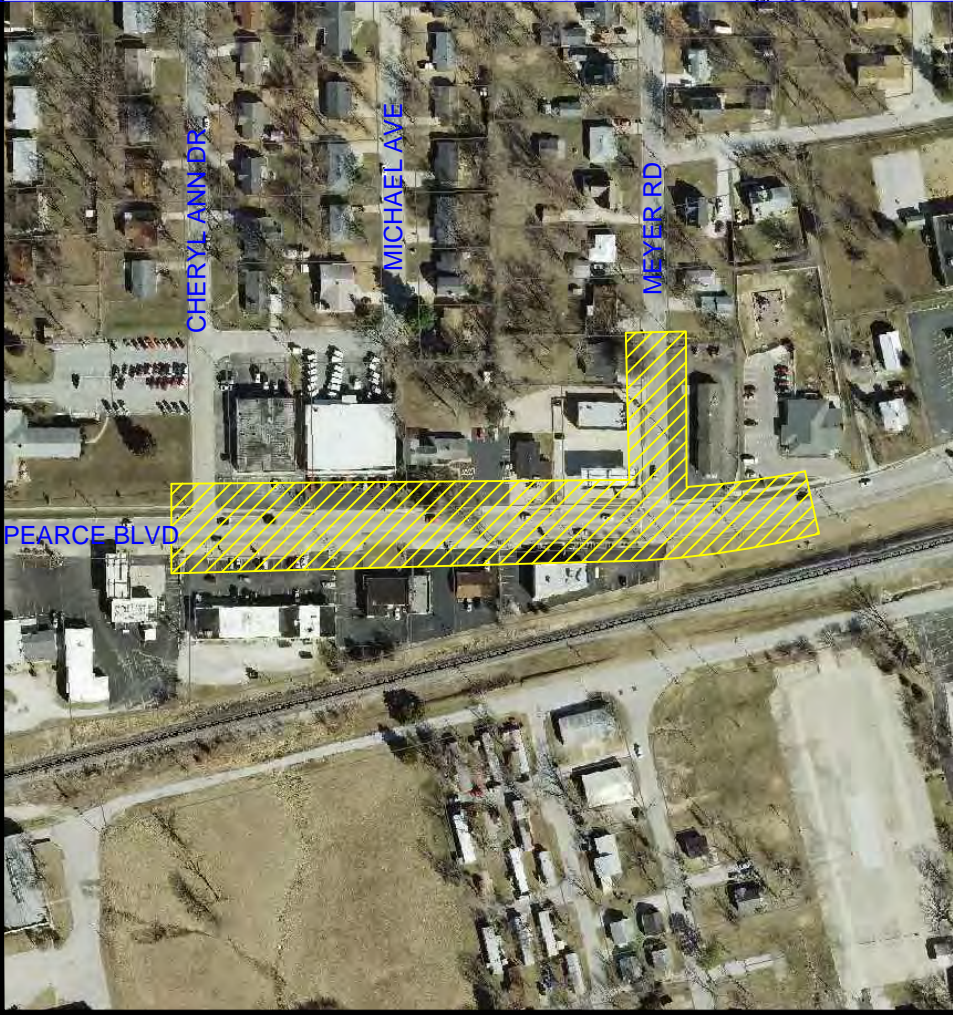
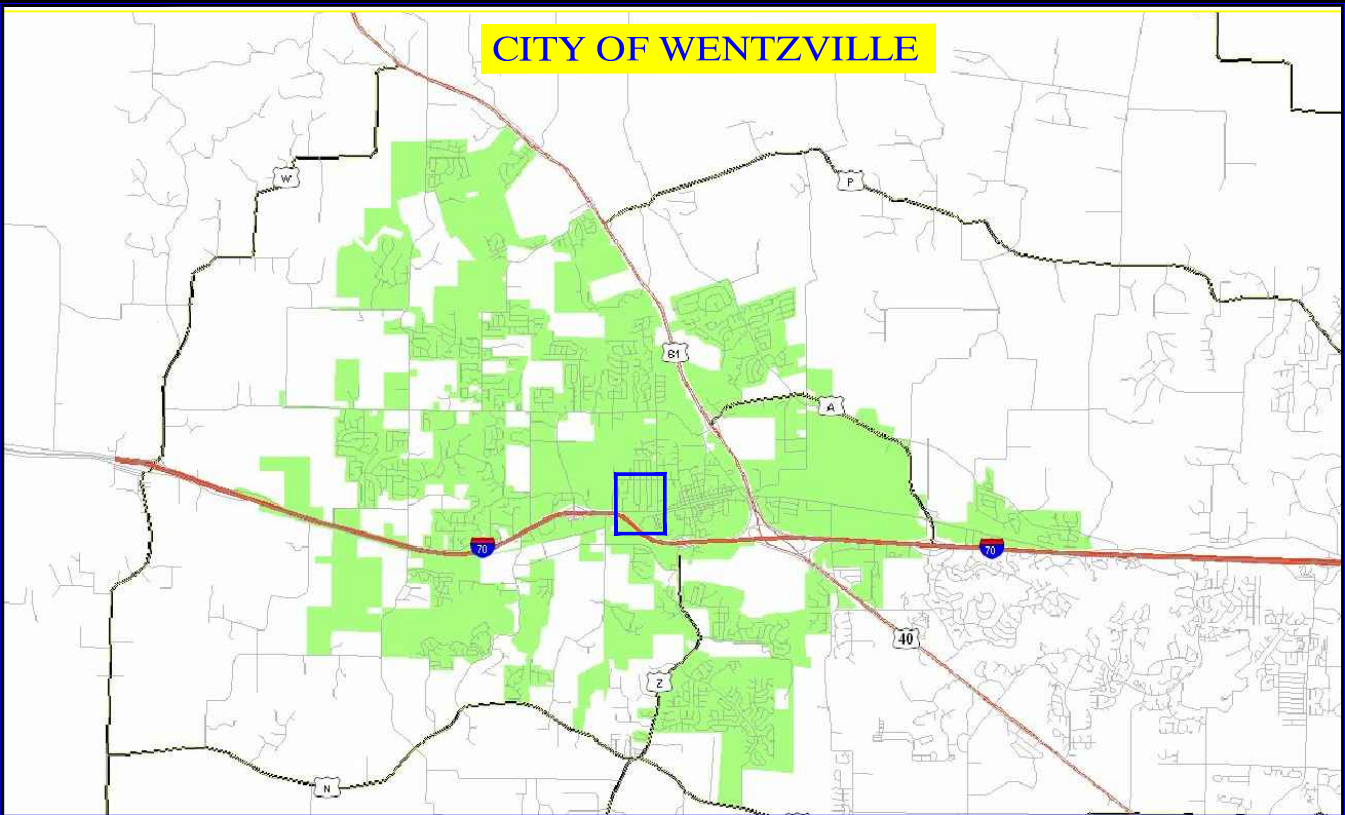
