SYSTEMIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Project Location:

Elm Street from Sierra Point Drive to Kingshighway Street, Kingshighway Street from Randolph Street to Sibley Street, Boone's Lick Road from Main Street to Gustane Drive, and the intersection of Fifth Street and Randolph Street

Project Description:

This project focused specifically on low-cost safety improvements, as identified in the St. Charles County Strategic Highway Safety Plan completed in 2015 in partnership with the Missouri Department of Transportation and the St. Louis Region of the Missouri Coalition for Roadway Safety. The project implemented multiple safety countermeasures which included installing reflective strips on signposts, object marker signs on fixed objects, and reflective backplates on signal heads. To better define the roadway limits, centerline and edgeline striping was provided. To bring attention to stop-controlled locations, stop bars and “stop ahead” pavement markings, signage, and flashing LED stop signs were installed. For increased pedestrian visibility, Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons and pedestrian lighting was also provided.
