## WEST SUNNY HILL BOULEVARD EXTENSION

### Project Location:

West Sunny Hill Boulevard from Mexico Road to Woodside Hills Drive

### Project Description:

This project provided for a new roadway connection between Mexico Road and Woodside Hills Drive to complete West Sunny Hill Boulevard. The new roadway was constructed with 2-lanes and a left-turn lane at the intersection with Mexico Road. The project included the construction of a new bridge over a tributary to Dardenne Creek. A multi-use path was also provided along the east side of the road to connect into an existing path on the south side of Mexico Road. These paths provide multi-modal users access to the existing Dardenne Greenway Trail that crosses under Mexico Road just east of the intersection with West Sunny Hill Boulevard.
