WENTZVILLE PARKWAY TURNLANE PHASE 1

Project Location:

Wentzville Parkway from Schroeder Creek Boulevard to William Dierberg Drive

Project Description:

This project provided for the widening of Wentzville Parkway. This was the first phase of improvements to widen the roadway from a 4-lane to a 5-lane section. The addition of this lane helped improve safety by allowing for a center two-way left-turn lane to be striped. To better accommodate both pedestrians and bicycles, the project also included upgrading the existing sidewalk. The sidewalk on the north side was replaced with a 6-foot-wide sidewalk and the sidewalk on the south side was upgraded to a 10-foot-wide multi-use path.

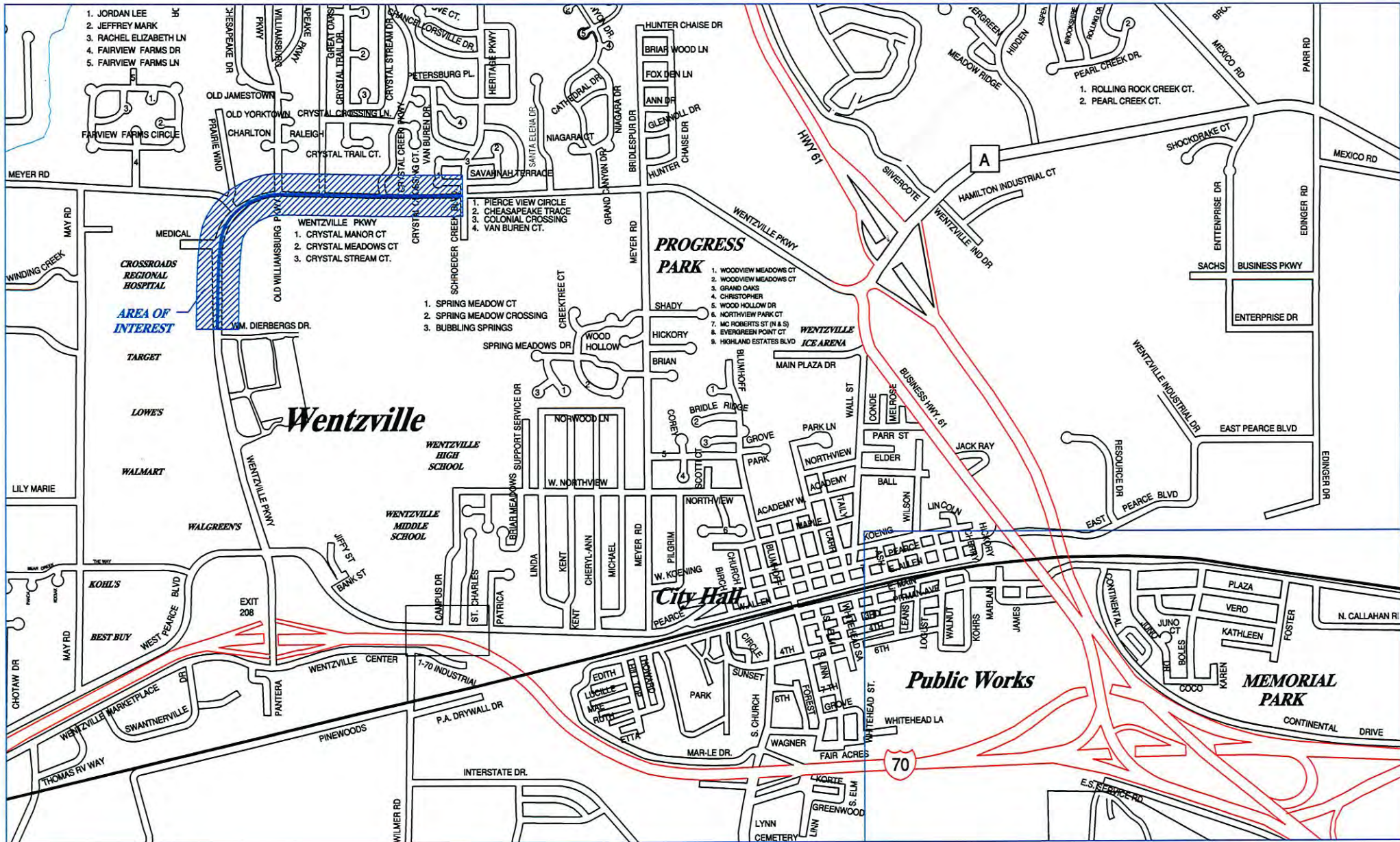
