FREYMUTH ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Project Location:

Freyimuth Road from Veterans Memorial Parkway to Prospect Road/Picardy Drive

Project Description:

This project provided for the reconstruction and widening of Freyimuth Road to improve the existing roadway and provide for ADA compliant bicycle and pedestrian facilities. The road was widened between Veterans Memorial Parkway and Founders Park Drive to provide for a 2-lane median divided roadway, tapering back to a 2-lane non-divided roadway section south of Founders Park Drive. The reconstruction included new curb and gutter with a new storm water system. Additionally, the roadway was widened to provide turn lanes at the intersections of Founders Park Drive and Prospect Road along with the addition of some on-street parking. To accommodate bicycles and pedestrians, an 8-foot-wide multi-use path was constructed along the west side of the roadway between Founders Park Drive and Prospect Road/Picardy Drive.

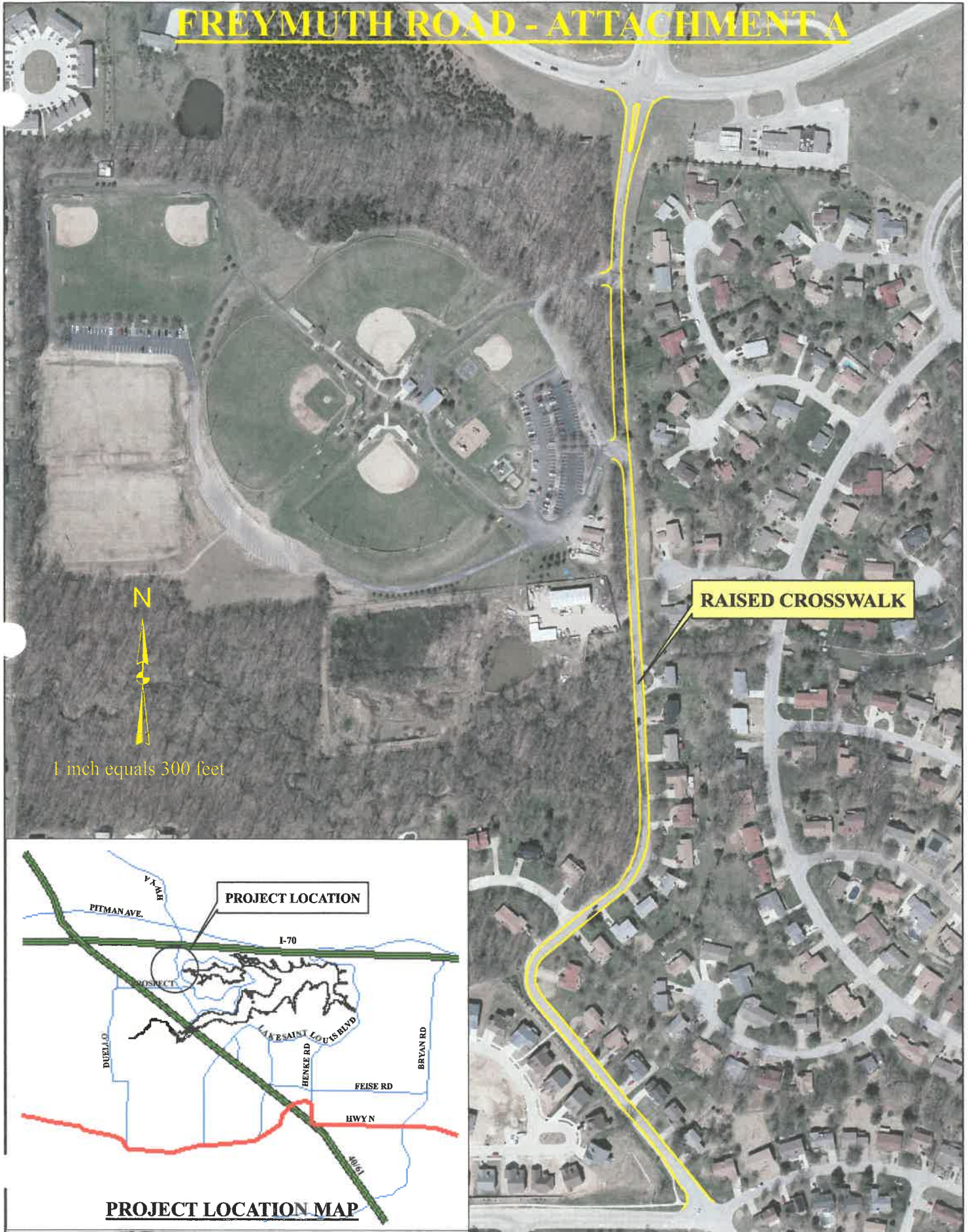

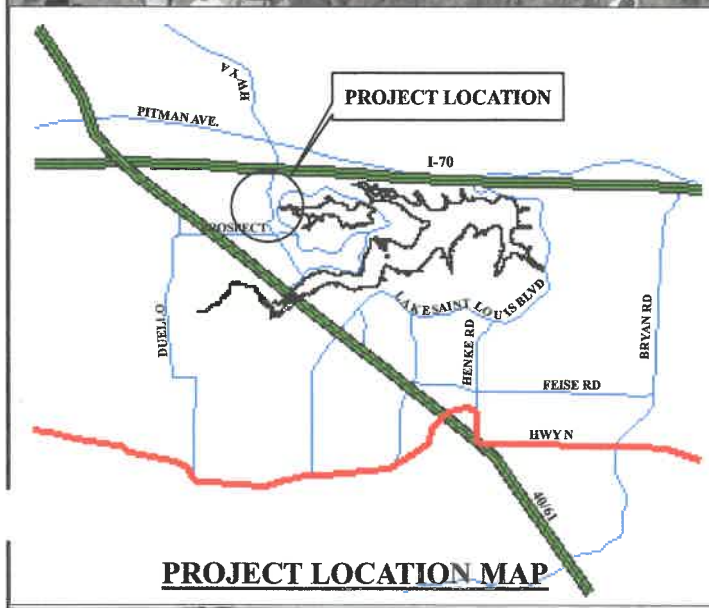
