SOMMERS ROAD AND ROUTE N INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

Project Location:

Intersection of Sommers Road and Route N

Project Description:

The purpose of this project was to improve traffic flow at the intersection. The improvements included widening of both the northbound (Sommers Road) and southbound (Ronald Reagan Drive) legs of the intersection to provide for a separate through lane and right-turn lane in each direction. The project included widening of both eastbound and westbound Route N to provide for two through lanes, a left-turn lane, and a right-turn lane in each direction. The traffic signal at the intersection was reconstructed to provide for these new turning movements. Two new signalized pedestrian crossings were also included with the new signal installation, an east-west crossing of Ronald Reagan Drive, and a north-south crossing of Route N on the west side of the intersection. The existing sidewalk was reconfigured and new curb ramps were installed to incorporate into the new intersection layout. The funding listed below as “Other” was provided by Wentzville School District.

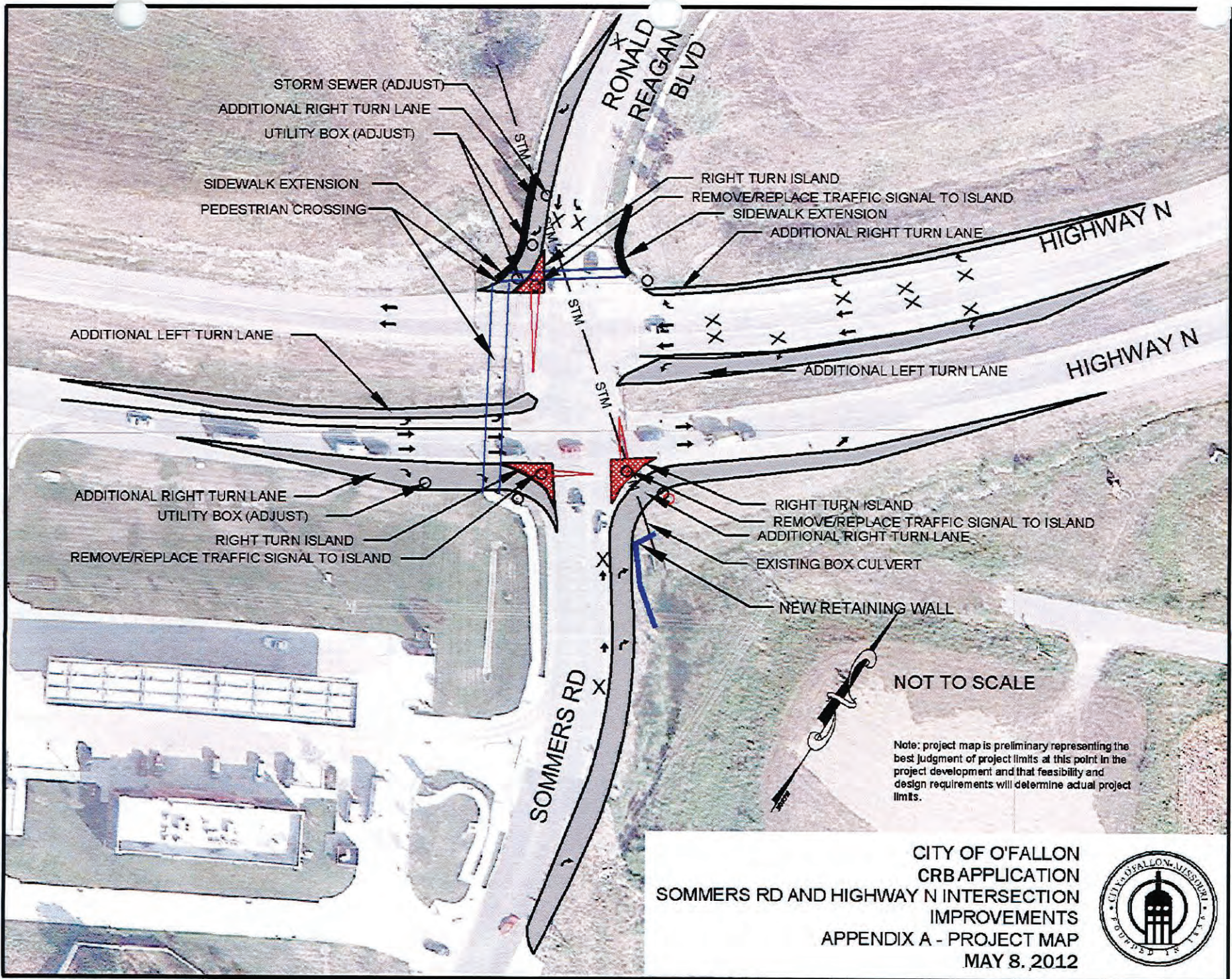
