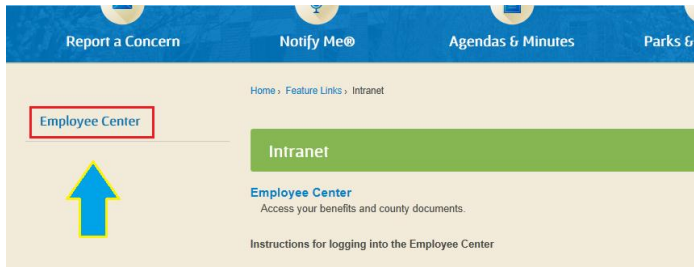


New County Website – Intranet Sign In Process

Internal Access-

1. Opening your web browser at your desk should automatically take you to the Intranet landing page. You can also access it by visiting www.sccmo.org/intranet.
2. Click “Employee Center” on the left.



Updated 10/23/2014:

3. You should now encounter a login screen like the one below. **For the username field, simply use your County-provided Windows username that you use to sign in to your computer.**

***Note:** The addition of @scc.county.zone after the username is now only required for website admins to be able to access the admin area of the site to add content or make edits. Website admins with the Sheriff’s Department should use @esscc.county.zone after the username – for example, jcool@esscc.county.zone.

4. Next, enter your County-provided Windows password.
5. Click the “Sign In” button.

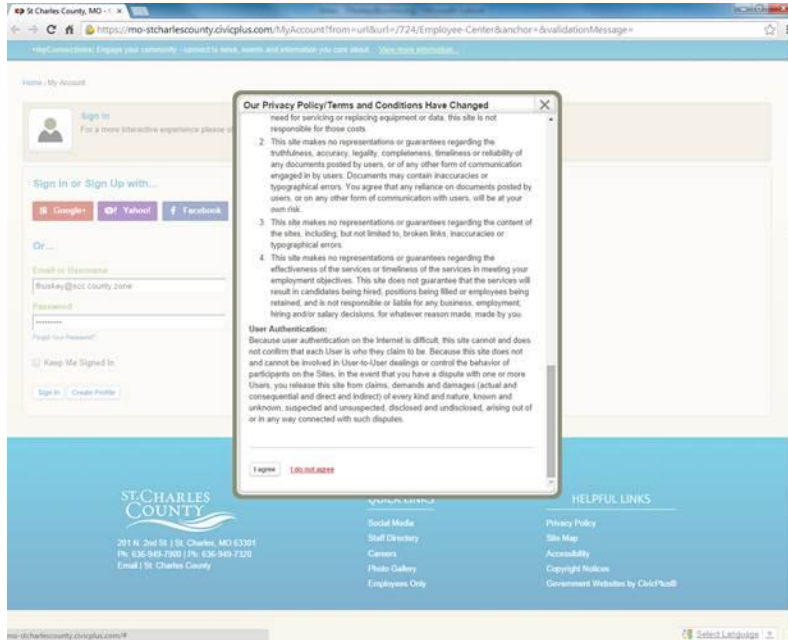
Please note:

Do not use Google+, Yahoo, or Facebook for accessing the Intranet.

If you receive an email asking you to validate your account, you may have logged in incorrectly.
