St. Charles County Parks Youth Activity Park Flying Field Rules

- 1. Drones, weighing under 55 pounds, are the only Unmanned Aircraft Systems allowed to operate on the Youth Activity Park Flying Field.
- 2. Must have a special use permit, issued by the St. Charles County Parks Department, on file. Applications for permits can be obtained from the County's website: www.sccmo.org
- 3. Comply with St. Charles County Parks Department Unmanned Aircraft Systems Policy and FAA guidelines.
- 4. Use must be for hobby or recreational purposes.
- 5. Fly below 400 feet and clear of obstacles.
- 6. Do not fly near or over people.
- 7. Do not survey or photograph park users.
- 8. Do not fly in adverse weather conditions.
- 9. Operators must check-in at the Youth Activity Park front desk.
- 10. Operators, spotters and spectators will be charged an admission fee at each visit.
- 11. Flying is only allowed in the designated flying area.
- 12. No more than four pilots are allowed to fly at the same time.
- 13. Flights will be limited to 20 minutes on busy days.
- 14. Keep drone in visual sight at all times.
- 15. Only pilots and their spotter are permitted on the field. Spectators will not be allowed on the field when in use.
- 16. Failure to comply with rules and policies can result in loss of flying privileges. Refunds will not be issued to anyone that is removed from the facility.
